The Lifeline Assistance Program ovides up to a \$13.00 credit on qualified residential customers' local monthly phone bills, including a federal credit of \$9.50, and a matching credit from their telephone company of \$3.50. Link-Up Florida provides up to a 50% reduction in the telephone service hook-up charge, to a maximum of \$30.00, making telephone service affordable to low-income consumers in our state.
