Application for increase in water rates in Highlands County by

Placid Lakes Utilities, Inc.

DOCKET NO. 130025-WU

On June 4, 2013, Placid Lakes Utilities, Inc. (Placid Lakes) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for increased water rates. Placid Lakes provides water service to over 1,940 customers in Highlands County.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for Placid Lakes' rate request, the Commission staff will conduct a customer meeting to allow customer feedback about Placid Lakes and the rate-setting process. Customer comments, written and oral, will be taken into consideration before the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.

2 Why is Placid Lakes requesting a rate increase?

Placid Lakes is requesting a rate increase to cover increasing operating costs.

When was Placid Lakes' last approved rate increase?

Placid Lakes' last approved rate increase was in 2009.

4 Presently, how much is the average monthly water bill for customers?

Currently, the average monthly water bill for customers is \$25.78.

5 Using Placid Lakes' proposed rates, how much would the average monthly water bill be for customers?

Under Placid Lakes' proposal, the average monthly water bill for customers would be \$32.21.


