Petition for rate increase by

### **Gulf Power Company**

DOCKET NO. 130140-EI

On July 12, 2013, Gulf Power Company (Gulf) filed a petition with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for a rate increase. Gulf provides electric service to more than 438,000 customers in 8 Northwest Florida counties.

#### QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

# 1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for Gulf's rate request, the Commission will conduct two customer service hearings to allow customer feedback about Gulf and the rate-setting process. Customer comments, written and oral, will be taken into consideration before the Commission reaches a decision. Commissioners will attend and participate during the customer service hearings.

## **2** Why is Gulf requesting a rate increase?

Gulf states that it is requesting a rate increase to cover increasing operating costs and for an opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

## When was Gulf's last approved base rate increase?

Gulf's last approved base rate increase was in 2012.

Presently, how much is the monthly electric bill for a residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kwh)?

Currently, the monthly electric bill for a residential customer using 1,000 kwh is \$118.88.

# 5 Using Gulf's proposed rates, how much would the monthly electric bill be for a residential customer using 1.000 kwh?

Under Gulf's proposal, the monthly electric bill for a residential customer using 1,000 kwh would be \$127.82.

# What would be the proposed monthly electric bill for a residential customer using 1,000 kwh if Gulf is granted a step increase in 2015?

If the Commission does not approve recovery of certain costs through the Environmental Cost Recovery Clause, but grants recovery through base rates as requested in this docket, then the 1,000 kwh residential monthly electric bill would be \$129.81, effective July 2015.

#### What if I cannot attend the customer service hearings or prefer not to speak? Are there other ways to comment on this case?
