Petition for limited proceeding to restructure rates by

St. Joe Natural Gas Company, Inc.

DOCKET NO. 160033-GU

On February 12, 2016, St. Joe Natural Gas Company, Inc. (St. Joe) filed a petition with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for a limited proceeding to restructure rates. St. Joe currently provides natural gas to approximately 3,000 residential and commercial customers in Port St. Joe, Mexico Beach, Wewahitchka, and unincorporated areas of Gulf County, Florida.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for St. Joe's restructuring request, the Commission staff will conduct a customer meeting to allow customer feedback about St. Joe and the process by which the company's petition is being evaluated. Customer comments, written and oral, will be taken into consideration when the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.

2 Why is St. Joe requesting a rate restructuring?

St. Joe lost its only industrial customer. The company is requesting to restructure rates to recover \$285,011 in lost annual revenues, thereby allowing the company to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

3 When was St. Joe's last approved rate increase?

St. Joe's current rates were established by the Commission in 2008.

Presently, how much is the average monthly bill (22 therms) for residential customers?

The average monthly bill (including gas cost) for St. Joe customers is \$40.58. This amount excludes energy conservation cost recovery charges, state and local government taxes, and franchise fees.

5 Using St. Joe's requested restructured rates, how much would the average monthly bill be for residential customers?

The average monthly bill (including gas cost) using St. Joe's requested restructured rates would be \$47.25 for residential customers.

6 What if I cannot attend the customer meeting or prefer not to speak? Are there other ways to comment on this case?
