Application for increase in wastewater rates in Gulf County by

### ESAD Enterprises d/b/a Beaches Sewer System

#### DOCKET NO. 160165-SU

On July 12, 2016, ESAD Enterprises d/b/a Beaches Sewer System (Beaches) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for an increase in wastewater rates. Beaches provides wastewater service to approximately 300 wastewater customers in Gulf County.

#### QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

# 1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for Beaches' rate request, the Commission staff will conduct a customer meeting to allow customer feedback about Beaches and the rate-setting process. Customer comments, written and oral, will be taken into consideration when the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.

# **2** Why is Beaches requesting a rate increase?

Beaches is requesting a rate increase in order to recover the cost of operating the utility and allow the company the opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

# **3** When was Beaches' last approved rate increase?

The last PSC staff-assisted rate case for this system occurred in 1988.

4 How much is the current monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer?

The current monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer is \$32.20.

**5** Using staff's preliminary rates, how much would the monthly wastewater bill be for a residential customer?

The monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer would be \$39.81.
