Application for increase in wastewater rates in Monroe County by

K W Resort Utilities Corp.

DOCKET NO. 20170141-SU

On November 21, 2017, K W Resort Utilities Corp (KWRU) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for an increase in wastewater rates. KWRU provides service to approximately 1,865 wastewater customers in Monroe County.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for KWRU's rate request, the Commission will conduct customer service hearings to allow customer feedback about KWRU and the rate-setting process. Customer comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. Commissioners will attend and participate during the hearings.

2 Why is KWRU requesting a rate increase?

KWRU is requesting a rate increase in order to recover the cost of operating the utility and allow the company to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

3 When was KWRU's last approved rate increase?

KWRU's last approved rate increase was in 2015.

4 Presently, how much is the monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer using 5,000 gallons?

The current monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer using 5,000 gallons is \$60.47.

5 Using KWRU's requested final rates, how much would the monthly wastewater bill be for a residential customer using 5,000 gallons?

Using KWRU's requested final rates, the monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer using 5,000 gallons would be \$92.79.

6 What if I cannot attend the customer service hearing or prefer not to speak? Are there other ways to comment on this case?
