Application for increase in water and wastewater rates in Lake County by

Pine Harbour Waterworks, Inc.

On January 23, 2018, Pine Harbour Waterworks, Inc. (Pine Harbour) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for an increase in water rates. Pine Harbour provides water service in Lake County to approximately 65 residential customers.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for Pine Harbour's rate request, the Commission staff will conduct a customer meeting to allow feedback about Pine Harbour and the rate-setting process. Comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.

2 Why is Pine Harbour requesting a rate increase?

Pine Harbour is requesting a rate increase in order to recover the cost of operating the utility and allow the company the opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

3 When was Pine Harbour's last approved rate increase?

Pine Harbour has never had a rate case while under Commission jurisdiction.

4 How much is the current monthly water bill for a residential customer of Palm Harbour using 4,000 gallons?

The utility's current monthly water bill for a residential customer using 4,000 gallons is \$25.96.

5 Using staff's recommended rates, how much would the monthly water bill be for a residential customer of Pine Harbour using 4,000 gallons?

Using staff's recommended rates, the monthly bill for a residential customer using 4,000 gallons would be \$34.79.

6 What if I cannot attend the customer meeting or prefer not to speak? Are there other ways to comment on this case?
