Application for increase in wastewater rates in Volusia County by

North Peninsula Utilities Corporation

DOCKET NO. 20180138-SU

On July 20, 2018, North Peninsula Utilities Corporation (North Peninsula) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for an increase in wastewater rates. North Peninsula provides wastewater service to approximately 430 residential customers in Volusia County.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for North Peninsula's rate request, the Commission staff will conduct a customer meeting to allow feedback about North Peninsula and the rate-setting process. Comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.

2 Why is North Peninsula requesting a rate increase?

North Peninsula is requesting a rate increase to recover the cost of operating the utility and allow the company the opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

When was North Peninsula's last approved rate increase?

North Peninsula's last approved rate increase was in 2000.

4 How much is the current monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer of North Peninsula?

The utility's current monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer is \$33.11.

5 Using staff's proposed rates, how much would the monthly wastewater bill be for a residential customer of North Peninsula?

Using staff's proposed rates, the monthly wastewater bill for a residential customer would be \$40.79.
