

Application for limited proceeding water rate increase in Lake County by

Lakeside Waterworks, Inc.

DOCKET NO. 20190146-WS

On July 25, 2019, Lakeside Waterworks, Inc. (Lakeside) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for a limited proceeding rate case. Lakeside provides water service to approximately 180 residential customers and 3 general service customers in Lake County.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for Lakeside's rate request, the Commission staff will conduct a customer meeting to allow feedback about Lakeside and the rate-setting process. Comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.

2 Why is Lakeside requesting a rate increase?

Lakeside is requesting a rate increase in order to recover the cost of operating the utility and allow the company an opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

3 When was Lakeside's last approved rate increase?

Lakeside's last approved rate increase was in 2017.

4 How much is the current monthly water bill for a residential customer of Lakeside using 3,000 gallons?

The utility's current monthly water bill for a residential customer using 3,000 gallons is \$28.30.

5 Using the utility's proposed rates, how much would the monthly water bill be for a residential customer of Lakeside using 3,000 gallons?

Using the utility's proposed rates, the monthly water bill for a residential customer using 3,000 gallons would be \$33.94.

6 What if I cannot attend the customer meeting or prefer not to speak? Are there other ways to comment on this case?
