Application for increase in water rates in Gulf County by

Lighthouse Utilities Company, Inc.

DOCKET NO. 20190118-WU

On July 12, 2019, Lighthouse Utilities Company, Inc. (Lighthouse) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for an increase in water rates. Lighthouse provides water service to approximately 1,850 customers in Gulf County.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for Lighthouse's rate request, the Commission staff will conduct a customer meeting to allow feedback about Lighthouse and the rate-setting process. Comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.

2 Why is Lighthouse requesting a rate increase?

Lighthouse is requesting a rate increase to recover the cost of operating the utility and allow the company an opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

3 When was Lighthouse's last approved rate increase?

Lighthouse's last approved rate increase from a rate proceeding was in 2011. Lighthouse's most recent approved rate increase was from a price index application in 2019.

4 How much is the current monthly water bill for a residential customer of Lighthouse using 2,000 gallons?

The utility's current monthly water bill for a residential customer using 2,000 gallons is \$22.33.

5 Using the Utility's proposed rates, how much would the monthly water bill be for a residential customer of Lighthouse using 2,000 gallons?

Using the Utility's proposed rates, the monthly water bill for a residential customer using 2,000 gallons would be \$29.64.

What if I cannot attend the customer meeting or prefer not to speak? Are there other ways to comment on this case?
