Application for a staff-assisted rate case in Polk County by

McLeod Gardens Utilities, LLC

DOCKET NO. 20200168-WU

On June 19, 2020, McLeod Gardens Utilities, LLC (McLeod or Utility) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for an increase in water rates. McLeod provides water service to approximately 95 residential customers in Polk County.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Why is McLeod requesting a rate increase?

McLeod is requesting a rate increase in order to recover the costs of replacing a well house, to implement a meter replacement program, and to account for increased operating expenses.

2 When was McLeod's last approved rate increase?

McLeod's rates were last approved in a 2002 rate case. Subsequent to the Utility's last rate case, its rates have been amended through five price index increases.

3 How much is the current monthly water bill for a residential customer of Mc-Leod using 5,000 gallons?

The Utility's current monthly water bill for a residential customer using 5,000 gallons is \$26.73.

4 Using staff's preliminary recommended rates, how much would the monthly water bill be for a residential customer of McLeod using 5,000 gallons?

Using staff's preliminary recommended rates, the monthly water bill for a residential customer using 5,000 gallons would be \$37.23.

5 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for McLeod's rate request, Commission staff will conduct a virtual customer meeting to allow feedback about McLeod and the rate-setting process. Comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.

Please sign up as soon as possible, but preferably two business days prior to the virtual customer meeting. 6 What if I cannot attend the virtual customer meeting or prefer not to speak? Are there other ways to comment on this case?
