Application for increase in water rates in Washington County by

Sunny Hills Utility Company

DOCKET NO. 20220066-WS

On April 7, 2022, Sunny Hills Utility Company (Sunny Hills or Utility) filed an application for an increase in water rates with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission). Sunny Hills is a Class B water and wastewater utility serving 585 residential customers and 18 general service customers in Washington County.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1 Why is Sunny Hills requesting a rate increase?

Sunny Hills is requesting a rate increase to recover the cost of operating the Utility and allow the company an opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

2 When was Sunny Hills' last approved rate increase?

Sunny HIlls has not had rates established since its transfer from Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. The Utility's last rate case under the name Aqua Utilities was in 2012.

3 How much is the current monthly water bill for a residential customer of Sunny Hills using 4,000 gallons?

The Utility's current monthly water bill for a residential customer of Sunny Hills using 4,000 gallons is \$47.05.

4 Using the Utility's proposed rates, how much would the monthly water bill be for a residential customer of Sunny Hills using 4,000 gallons?

Using the Utility's proposed rates, the monthly water bill for a residential customer using 4,000 gallons would be \$49.87.

5 Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process for Sunny Hills' rate request, Commission staff will conduct a virtual customer meeting to allow feedback about Sunny Hills and the rate-setting process. Comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. One or more Commissioners may attend and participate during the customer meeting.


