On November 7, 2022, Lake Yale Utilities, LLC (Lake Yale) filed an application for a limited alternative rate increase (LARI) to recover the incremental increase in operating costs over the amount approved in the utility's last rate proceeding. Lake Yale is a Class C water utility serving 299 residential customers, 88 irrigation customers, and 1 general service customer in Pasco County. The utility is serving 299 residential wastewater customer and 1 general service customer. The utility is operated under Florida Utility Services 1, LLC (FUS1), a service company.

 Why is Lake Yale requesting a rate increase? Lake Yale is requesting a rate increase to recover the incremental increase in operating costs over the amount approved in the utility's last rate proceeding. When was Lake Yale's last approved rate increase? Lake Yale's last rate case was approved in 2022. However, the utility has had two price index rate adjustments.
