## DOCKET NO. 20220185-WS

On November 7, 2022, Sunrise Water, LLC (Sunrise) filed an application for a limited alternative rate increase (LARI) to recover the incremental increase in operating costs over the amount approved in the utility's last rate proceeding. Sunrise is a Class C water utility providing service in Polk County to 260 residential customers and 3 general service customers. The City of Lakeland provides water service to the customers. The utility is operated under Florida Utility Services 1, LLC (FUS1), a service company.
