On February 12, 2024, Environmental Utilities, LLC (EU or Utility) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission or PSC) for a certificate to provide wastewater service in Charlotte County. The proposed service area includes the barrier islands of Little Gasparilla Island, Don Pedro Island, and Knight Island.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1. Why is EU requesting a certificate to provide wastewater service?

EU is requesting a certificate to provide wastewater service to customers of the barrier islands of Little Gasparilla Island, Don Pedro Island, and Knight Island, who are currently served by septic systems.

2. Is there an opportunity for public input on this certificate request?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process of EU's request, Commission staff will conduct in-person service hearings to allow feedback about EU's quality of service and the rate setting process. Comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. Commissioners will attend and participate during the service hearings.

Customers may sign-up to speak at the service hearings upon arrival at the venue. Please note that the order in which customers will speak is based on the order in which they sign-up. If you have questions about the sign-up process, please call (850) 413-7080.

All persons who wish to comment in-person, are urged to appear promptly at the scheduled times because the service hearings may be adjourned early if no customers are present to testify or when those present have testified.

5. How much would the monthly bill be for a residential customer of EU using 6,000 gallons?

The monthly bill for a residential customer of EU using 6,000 gallons would be \$221.21.

6. Who provides legal representation for customers in utility related matters before the Public Service Commission?

The Office of Public Counsel (OPC) was established by the Florida Legislature to advocate on behalf of you and the other utility customers before the Commission and other state and federal regulatory authorities.
