The following is a summary of the programs the City operates to promote, encourage and expands the use of renewable energy and/or energy conservation and efficiency measures.

- The City implemented a policy that permits interconnection and net-metering of customer-owned renewable generation systems.
- The City implemented a program to minimize electric system losses thereby increasing the efficiency of our electric system.
- The City hires Professional Engineering consultants to perform load flow models to determine deficiencies in the electric system.
- The City implements capital projects each year to storm harden the electric system and correct deficiencies.
