Application for increase in water and wastewater rates by Sunshine Water Services Company

DOCKET NO. 20240068-WS

On June 28, 2024, Sunshine Water Services Company (Sunshine or Utility) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission or PSC) for increased water and wastewater rates for its customers in Charlotte, Highlands, Lake, Lee, Marion, Orange, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, and Seminole Counties. Sunshine is a Class A utility providing service to 34,740 water and 28,892 wastewater customers.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1. Why is Sunshine requesting a rate increase?

Sunshine is requesting a rate increase to recover the cost of operating the Utility and allow the company an opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on its investment.

2. When was Sunshine's last approved rate increase?

Sunshine's last rate case was in 2020.

3. Is there an opportunity for public input on this rate case?

Yes. As part of the evaluation process of Sunshine's rate request, Commission staff will conduct virtual and in-person service hearings to allow feedback about Sunshine's quality of service and the rate setting process. Comments will be reviewed before the Commission reaches a decision. Commissioners will attend and participate during the service hearings.

Customers may register to speak at the virtual service hearings in one of the following ways: (1) register using the PSC's online registration form, which will be available at www.FloridaPSC.com, under the "Hot Topics" heading, (2) call the PSC at (850) 413-7080 or (3) email speakersignup@psc.state.fl.us. Online registration for the virtual service hearings will open on November 19, 2024 at 9:00 a.m., and close at noon two business days prior to each virtual service hearing.

One day prior to the virtual service hearings customers who signed up to speak will be provided further instructions from PSC staff on how to participate.

Customers who wish to speak at the in-person service hearings may register upon arrival at the venue.

All persons who wish to comment, either virtually or in-person, are urged to appear promptly at the scheduled times because the service hearings may be adjourned early if no customers are present to testify or when those present have testified. Please note that the order in which customers will speak is based on the order in which they register. If you have questions about the sign-up process, please call (850) 413-7080.

6. How much is the current and proposed monthly water bill for a Sunshine customer using 4,000 gallons?

The current monthly water bill for a Sunshine customer using 4,000 gallons is \$21.17. The proposed monthly water bill for a Sunshine customer using 4,000 gallons would be \$25.95.

7. How much is the current and proposed monthly wastewater bill for a Sunshine customer using 6,000 gallons?

The current monthly wastewater bill for a Sunshine customer using 6,000 gallons is \$68.53. The proposed monthly wastewater bill for a Sunshine customer using 6,000 gallons would be \$79.47.

8. Who provides legal representation for customers in utility related matters before the Public Service Commission?

The Office of Public Counsel was established by the Florida Legislature to advocate on behalf of you and the other utility customers before the Commission and other state and federal regulatory authorities. The Office of Public Counsel is independent from the Commission, and accountable only to the people of the State of Florida through the Florida Legislature. 10. How can I follow the service hearings and Commission Conferences?

11. When will the PSC make a decision?

After the technical hearing is completed, the PSC staff will file a recommendation with the Commission that addresses Sunshine's proposed revenue increase. The Commissioners will then vote on this matter at a future Commission Conference.

Based on the Commission's decision on Sunshine's proposed revenue increase, staff will prepare another recommendation that addresses the specific rates to be charged to each class of customers. The Commission will then vote on Sunshine's rates at a future Commission Conference.
